Raw material sourcing sustainability initiatives

Ingredients, packaging & logistics

Packaging:

1. Plastic: optimisation of plastic liner density (μ) – current.
2. Cardboard: 90% of all cardboard is recycled, 10% is FSC certified.
3. All packaging pallets are optimised in terms of build and transport.
4. Feasibility for “no liner” food contact boxes for all finished product – future.

Ingredients:

1. Raw material sourcing carbon tracker for RM supply chain.
2. Removal of Palm oil as an ingredient (alternative now in place).

Logistics:

1. Reduction of external finished product stockholding and reduction in km travelled for product with point to point delivery.





Resource usage sustainability initiatives

Energy usage, water & waste management

- Energy:
1. Heat recovery from Refrigeration plant and process equipment to provide hot water and space heating for the site.
 2. Planned installation of Energy monitoring system for the site.
 3. Optimisation of controls for refrigeration plant, i.e. floating head pressure control, evaporator cycling, cold store set point to maximise efficient operation.
 4. Compressed air efficiency:- surveyed and maintenance programme now in place for manufacturing.

Water: Installation of sub meters to facilitate efficient water use for the site.

Waste management: Waste mgmt. plan in place for all business units – colour coded system for waste segregation
All waste streams managed as per waste hierarchy.
